## Join the Patient & Family Advisory Council (PFAC)

### Be a part of improving health care!

**Thank you for your interest in the Patient & Family Advisory Council! We are excited to share next steps with you. Please reach out if you have any further questions.**

#### **Step One – Sign up-RSVP Form**

Please go to the RSVP Page. This information helps guide further conversations about your interest in this opportunity and can help us support you as a Patient Advisor.

Be as specific as possible about your patient, family and/or caregiver experience in health care. While we understand that people who work in health care have those experiences, we are seeking individuals who can represent lived experience from the patient, family or caregiver perspective.

The more information you are comfortable to share, the easier it is for us to follow up on your responses and clarify any further information needed.

#### **Step Two – Patient Advisor Intake Call**

The purpose of this call is to follow up on your RSVP, give you further information about what being a patient advisor means and ensure your interest for reaching out aligns with the role of a Patient Advisor.

As there are many people who want to provide feedback into health care, we want to make sure that being a Patient Advisor is a great fit for you! After this call, if there is agreement that being a Patient Advisor is the right volunteer role for you, we will send your RSVP to the health care team. **(If you are a current Patient Voices Network member, you have already completed this step)**

#### **Step Three – Health Care Partner Follow-Up**

The RSVP form gives the health care team, who will be making the PFAC selections, more specific information about why you are interested in this opportunity, what experience you bring and what your availability is. They will review all RSVP's and directly contact those that they would like to meet with to discuss joining their team.

#### **Step Four – Meet & Greet**

This is an informal meeting to discuss the current work of the PFAC and ask questions about your interest. This is also a chance for you to ask questions and determine if you find this opportunity a good fit for you. Once the Meet & Greet is complete, the PFAC team will be in touch about whether to move forward in partnership and more details will be provided about meeting dates/times. If they determine that they won't be moving forward with you at this time, someone will be in touch to let you know.
